NGĀI TAHU Tourism's Tiki Tour "A Pathway to a Career in Tourism"

Ngāi Tahu Tourism has created "Tiki Tour" a trial initiative to encourage young Ngāi Tahu to work or study in the tourism sector. It's aimed at young Ngāi Tahu from the Ōtākou (Otago) and Murihiku (Southland) regions, and its purpose is to actively engage and show young Ngāi Tahu the range of career pathways within the tourism sector.

Participants will travel into Queenstown to meet tourism professionals, learn first hand about what they do, and be shown the type of skills, attributes and training needed to work in the tourism sector. This kaupapa will focus on "hands on" learning and will include sampling some of the awesome adventure tourism products owned by Ngāi Tahu Tourism.

Participants will be shown the operations of our iwi-owned tourism businesses and meet the experts that run them, receiving insight into what it's like to work in the tourism sector, enriching their understanding of Ngāi Tahu Tourism businesses. With their new knowledge participants will plot their career path to a role in the tourism sector.

The ideal participant will be a mature and responsible Ngāi Tahu youth aged between 15-20 who has demonstrated leadership potential, is interested in a career in tourism and has a broad range of cultural, sporting or social pursuits. Our Tiki Tour will take place 27-28 September 2010. All transport, accommodation, kai and appropriate manaakitanga/adult supervision will be provided by NGĀI TAHU Tourism. Organisers will pick up and drop off participants from Ōtepoti (Dunedin) and Waihōpai (Invercargill).
